Inc. is pleased to continue offering Student Leadership Grants to secondary school students in Brantford.*

## **STUDENT LEADERSHIP GRANT PROGRAM**

Grants offered through this program are intended to encourage students to become more involved in the educational process and to promote teaching youth how to make positive choices when they are faced with contemporary issues in their peer group, family and community. The K.I.D.S. curriculum addresses five relevant topics: Youth and the law; peer-to-peer relationships; online and social media awareness; drug awareness; and mental health awareness.

Students from grade **9 to 12 in the City of Brantford** are eligible to apply to T.I.C.K. Inc. for one-time funding of a school-based project reflective of one of the topics mentioned above. Students are encouraged to be original and professional in their interpretation and presentation.

Grant values, **to a maximum of \$500**, will be awarded depending upon the nature and magnitude of the proposed project. Students will be required to indicate, in the written application, the approximate costs that may be incurred through the process of completing the project.

### **There are Two Types of Grants:**

1. Grants awarded to individual students who decide to undertake a creative project promoting positive choices related to one of the five topics.
2. Grants awarded to student groups who decide to undertake a creative project promoting positive choices related to one of the five topics.

### **How to Apply:**

Complete the application form provided, submit it for review by your teacher/advisor and forward it to the Board of T.I.C.K. Inc. via the address at the end of the application form.

Successful applicants will be required to present a report to T.I.C.K. Inc. at the conclusion of the project, highlighting the success of the project and the impact it had on their school.
